Ms Nomfundo Maseti holds a BA Hon degree in Economics. She started her career teaching economics and business economics for three years. She joined the Competition Commission wherein she held various positions including serving as a Senior Economist and had an opportunity to regulate conduct of various corporates in South Africa through undertaking major investigations pertaining to price fixing and abuse of dominance with great success.

She has extensive knowledge of industrial economics, regulatory economics and economics of competition law and consumer law which are imperative in the sustainable development and regulation of the piped gas industry.
