



CALL FOR NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES TO SERVE AS PART-TIME MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ENERGY REGULATOR OF SOUTH AFRICA (NERSA)

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipeline industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

The Minister of Mineral Resources and Energy, Mr Gwede Samson Mantashe, MP has in terms of section 6 (7) of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004) called for nomination of candidates from members of the public to serve as part-time Regulator Members as per *government gazette* No. 45356 of 22 October 2021.
