



## NOTICE ON THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE FIFTH MULTI YEAR PRICE DETERMINATION (MYPD5) REVENUE APPLICATION

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA’s mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

Eskom submitted its fifth Multi-Year Price Determination (MYPD5) application on 2 June 2021, requesting to be allowed an amount of R279bn, R335bn and R365bn for financial years 2022/23, 2023/24 and 2024/25, respectively.

On 8 December 2021, NERSA published a consultation paper and Eskom’s MYPD5 application. The documents are available on the NERSA website at [www.nersa.org.za](http://www.nersa.org.za) (Electricity>Consultation>documents). NERSA will decide on Eskom’s revenue application for the 2022/2023 financial year in terms of the Multi-Year Pricing Determination Methodology published in 2016.

NERSA invites the public and all stakeholders to attend the scheduled public hearings on Eskom’s MYPD5 application. The public hearings will be conducted in all the provinces, as indicated in the schedule below.
