



CONSULTATION DOCUMENT ON THE IMPACT OF THE SURGE IN INTERNATIONAL GAS PRICES INTO THE SOUTH AFRICAN GAS PRICES, INTERIM METHODOLOGY, AND REVIEW OF THE METHODOLOGY TO APPROVE MAXIMUM PRICES OF PIPED-GAS
