



NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE AMENDMENT OF LICENCE CONDITIONS

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), the Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) ('the Gas Act') and the Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

NERSA will, in terms of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 read together with the Gas Act, decide on the applications of the amendment of licence conditions referred to herein.

Notice is hereby given that Sasol Gas (Pty) Ltd and SLG (Pty) Ltd are applying for the amendment of the conditions of their licences in terms of section 24(1)(a) of the Gas Act. The amendment applications are as set out below:

The closing date for the receipt of objections is 30 calendar days from the date of publication of this notice. Objections received after the closing date will be disregarded.
