



NOTICE TO COMMENT IN TERMS OF REGULATION 18 OF THE PROMOTION OF ADMINISTRATIVE JUSTICE ACT, 2000 (ACT NO. 3 OF 2000) REGARDING THE APPLICATION FOR A DISTRIBUTION CONNECTION FACILITY LICENCE TO BE CONSTRUCTED UNDER BUILD OWN AND OPERATE OPTION

The National Energy Regulator is a regulatory authority established in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). The National Energy Regulator's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

The National Energy Regulator received 3 applications from Karpowership SA (Pty) Ltd for distribution connection facility licences for dedicated lines, each from a licensed generation facility to a specified delivery point, to be constructed under the Build, Own and Operate (BOO) options. The description of the lines are as follows:

3	Karpowership SA Saldanha Bay	Western Cape	3.5km	132kV	Hoogland Switching Station
