### STAKEHOLDER WORKSHOP ON THE ELECTRICITY REGULATION STRATEGY

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) cordially invites stakeholders to a workshop on NERSA's Electricity Regulation strategy.

The Electricity Division of the Energy Regulator has concluded an extensive strategic review and planning process to address the rapidly transforming electricity industry. The strategy touches on a number of areas, including the ongoing unbundling of Eskom, the increase in the uptake of Renewable Energy (RE) technologies, as well as the increase in embedded and self-generation. With this workshop, NERSA hopes to:

- share with stakeholders the overarching strategic direction that NERSA is taking in response to the changes the electricity sector is facing;
- showcase NERSA's responses and the changes to its systems and tools, outlining NERSA's integrated plan and NERSA's actions are not random;
- create a platform that will facilitate dialogue between NERSA and stakeholders on the changes the electricity industry is facing from a regulatory point of view.

NERSA's strategy is aimed at ensuring system stability, price stability and accessibility. The revised strategy repositions NERSA to respond proactively with revitalised customer focus and improved regulatory efficiency for a more stable electricity industry.

NERSA's Electricity Regulation Division consulted with stakeholders throughout last year in an effort to solicit inputs into NERSA's strategy. The results of those efforts can now be communicated to stakeholders. NERSA, with renewed vigour, seeks to effectively discharge its mandate in the electricity industry and ensure that the objects of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006) are upheld, while balancing the rights and needs of consumers with those of licensees and registrants.
