STAKEHOLDER WORKSHOP ON THE ELECTRICITY INDUSTRY NEW PRICE DETERMINATION METHODOLOGY

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

In 2021, NERSA's Electricity Division initiated a process to develop an electricity industry new price determination methodology and published a consultation document on the principles that would underpin the new methodology. NERSA is now at the stage where the full details of the methodology are being consulted on.

The closing date for written comments is 29 July 2022.
