

PUBLIC HEARINGS ON THE METHODOLOGY FOR THE DETERMINATION OF TARIFFS AND PRICES IN THE ELECTRICITY INDUSTRY

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

On 30 June 2022, the Energy Regulator published a consultation paper on the methodology for the determination of tariff and prices in the electricity industry. The Closing Date for stakeholder comments is the 29 July 2022.

The National Energy Regulator invites the public and all stakeholders to attend the scheduled public hearings on Electricity Price Determination Methodology (EPDM) for the setting of tariff and prices in the South African Electricity Industry.
