

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and the Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

Notice is hereby given that NERSA has received the following applications for transmission tariffs:

- 1. Republic of Mozambique Pipeline Investment Company (ROMPCO) multi-year transmission tariff application for Loop Line 2 (GTA 3) for the period 1 January 2023 to 31 December 2025**
- 2. Transnet SOC Ltd ('Transnet') multi-year tariff application for the period 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2026.**

The abovementioned applications and the NERSA discussion documents are available to members of the public for comments on the NERSA website at www.nersa.org.za, as required by the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004).

The extended deadline for submitting comments on the ROMPCO Loop Line 2 (GTA 3) tariff application, as well as the deadline for submitting comments on the Transnet multi-year tariff application, is **13 March 2023**.
